Company profile

Dynaciv is the culmination of many years of experience in the application of various epoxy resins to strengthen structures. We have learnt how to adapt epoxy compounds to specifically suit the purpose to improve quality and increase value.

The Situation

Chemical protection systems have been around for a long time. However many are suited to specific purposes. Galvanising is an economical solution that is long-lasting and effective, however it is also limited to certain projects. One limitation of galvanising is that it cannot be used in acid conditions. Acids will quickly penetrate through galvanising and remove the zinc alloy coating.

Recently Dynaciv were contacted by a large galvanising plant to provide a long-term solution to protect their carrier beams and oven doors. The beams as shown in the photo below are used to transport metal sections from the various acid baths to the oven and finally to the hot dip bath. These beams are exposed to strong acids, moist conditions and temperatures in the excess of 400°C (when over the bath).

At the same galvanising plant, the client requested Dynaciv to also provide an economical solution to protect the oven doors. The doors had only been operating for 12 months and had shown signs of significant corrosion.

The Solution

Dynaciv were contacted to design a system that would protect the oven doors and beams.

One of the technical advisors visited the site to gain a clearer understanding of the coating requirements. A 300 mm X 1000 mm area was prepared to trail three recommended coatings. All coatings made by Dynaciv.

The three samples were tested for mechanical and chemical strength. Acid was poured on the hot surface and allowed to evaporate. It was also struck with sharp objects to test adhesion. Following these severe tests, sample 2 was chosen as the preferred coating as it had the superior:

- a. Flexibility
- b. Acid resistance
- c. Adhesion



To prepare the doors for the epoxy coating, we blasted the surface to a near white finish (AS.1627.4 Class $2\frac{1}{2}$).

Soon after a large section was blasted, we applied the first coat of the formulated epoxy to avoid flash rust. The epoxy was applied by a standard epoxy safe roller.



All the doors and supports received a coat of epoxy. After 24 hours, the entire structure received another coat of protective epoxy coating.

The end result is a protective coating that is guaranteed to extend the life of this important asset.
